

The radiant brilliance of these high quality decorative glasses from SAHM will be lasting as long as you take note of the following recommendations for your glasses:

WASH BY HAND

- Clean the glasses with a little glass cleaner in hand-warm-water.
- Rinse thoroughly with warm water and then with cold water.
- Put the clean glasses, with their opening at the bottom, onto a tray and allow to drip dry.
- Do not use tea towels to dry as these are usually not completely grease-free.
- Before pouring a drink, rinse dry glasses with cold water.

... IN GASTRONOMIC DISHWASHERS

- Do not clean decorated glasses in domestic dishwashers.
- Place the glasses properly into plastic baskets, with a locking mechanism, in the dishwasher. Avoid mechanical stresses (bumps, contact, rubbing).
- Do not wash glasses together with other dishes or cutlery.
- Use a special glass cleaning agent (must not contain caustic alkalis) and follow the manufacturer's dosing recommendations.
- Recommended water hardness: „2 (average)“ (1.3 to max.2.5 millimoles of calcium carbonate per litre), use a water softening system in necessary.
- Water pressure max. 0.3 to 0.4 bar.
- The ideal washing temperature is 60°C. Rinse aid solution (heated water + rinse aid) 65° +/- 2 °C
- Wash duration: max. 2 1/2 minutes.
- Immediately remove the glasses from the machine after washing.
- Allow warm glasses to cool down and do not shock them with cold water below 15°C.
- Before pouring a drink, rinse dry glasses with cold water.
- Please also follow the manufacturer's recommendations (both of the machine and of the washing agent).

Some customers in the UK are using a Renovator product in addition to traditional glass washing detergents. This product is very aggressive and can lead to the fast destruction of UV ink glass decoration. Destroyed decorations as a result of using a Renovator product is not part of SAHM's warranty promise.

Please rinse your glasses before first use!
